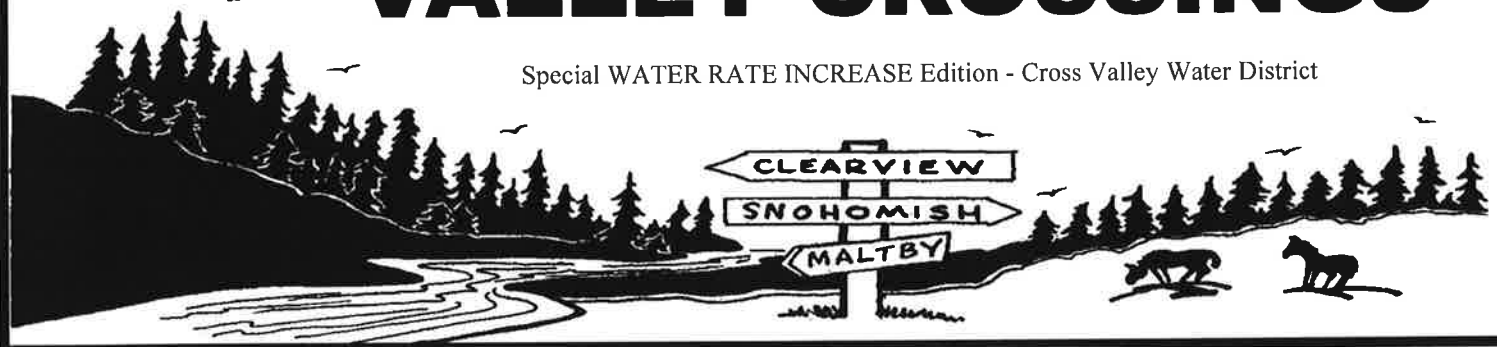

Estimated rate increases for Silver Lake Sewer: Single Family \$130.84 bi-monthly; Multi-family \$128.50 per unit bi-monthly. Estimated effective date for these rates is May 1, 2014.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

111th Ave. SE Culvert Replacement—This project is complete. Snohomish County replaced the culvert underneath 111th Ave SE and the District replaced the water main in the area of the culvert.

Echo Lake Standpipe Replacement—We are awaiting a hearing date for the required Conditional Use Permit.

Well #7 Replacement-We will be drilling a replacement well (#7B) in 2014. This will replace the existing well due to declining yields and formation issues

The following projects are dependent on Snohomish County's Schedule

Broadway Avenue Walkway—Snohomish County is proposing to add an 8 foot wide walkway along the west side of Broadway Avenue between Yew Way and 164th Street SE. The District may need to relocate some water services and mains.

240th Street SE—This Snohomish County project will widen 240th St. SE from the Woodinville-Snohomish Road to the proposed Wellington Hills Park entrance and also construct a roundabout, one raised table top intersection and two speed bumps. We may be required to relocate some water services, water mains, fire hydrants and raise sewer manholes west of the proposed park.

Springhetti Road & Broadway—The County will realign this intersection, construct retaining walls and guardrails. The District will need to relocate some water services and possibly move a portion of water main.

Maple Road Culvert Replacement—The existing culvert at approximately 9310 Maple Road will be replaced with a larger culvert. Relocation of our water main and a service will be required.

DID YOU KNOW?

Cross Valley Water District offers auto pay service as well as bills by email. Your bank account will be automatically drafted for the amount of your bill 10 days after billing. Currently we only offer auto pay through a checking or savings account. Please contact our office to setup either of these services.

*** Backflow Tests ***

Just a reminder that anyone who has an irrigation system, fire suppression system, latte stand, or swimming pool, per state law, must have your backflow device tested each calendar year. The tester must be state approved and the test results must be on file in our office. CVWD's annual backflow test deadline is April 30th of each year. For more information feel free to call our office. Regulation regarding cross-connection control can be found under WAC 246-290-490.
